Peace Winds 3 Month Report: Western Kentucky Tornado Response



In the months since a deadly tornado outbreak ripped across the South and the Midwest US, Peace Winds has partnered with Red Cross volunteers working around the clock to aid people whose lives were forever changed by this disaster. In western Kentucky, our support has focused on providing safe shelter, warm meals, and relief supplies to help survivors in the aftermath of the tragedy.

The benefits of Peace Winds' financial support through our Red Cross partner will last long after homes and towns are rebuilt. A contribution in the amount of \$35,300 was made to Western Kentucky Red Cross, providing additional financial assistance to bridge the gap between hardship and recovery. So far through our partner, these funds have been distributed to more than 1,500 families, helping them replace furniture and other items destroyed by the tornadoes, secure new housing, and pay for other necessities. Peace Winds' generous donors have helped survivors repair and rebuild their homes and have been instrumental in the recovery needs of communities affected by the December 2021 tornado outbreak.
